The different commissions involved in the UIA Business Law Forum – BLF will discuss recent legal developments and analyze the new regulations introduced by national and supranational entities aimed to tackle the new challenges arising from the new Covid-19 situation. The commissions will review the different regulations enacted by different jurisdictions to minimize the problems created by the pandemic and will compare approaches adopted in the relevant jurisdictions and their results. It will also be analyzed whether or not some of these new measures will outlast the pandemic and how they can improve the different business law practices.

In this session, we will analyze how the Covid-19 pandemic will likely have enduring impact on corporate governance and corporate transactions long after the pandemic subsides. Impacts of new FDI protective rules: stronger screening mechanisms and restrictions to foreign investment in times of pandemic.

The UIA Foreign Investment Commission has dedicated itself during the last months to prepare a study on Worldwide basis about national restrictions on FDI. We come to the conclusion that though some areas are commonly subject to restriction for FDI, such as the military sector, the presence of other restrictions may vary a lot from country to country. Furthermore, in quite a few jurisdictions there is also the presence of the so-called screening mechanisms which are not necessarily related to FDI, but in fact may create conditions for them. We also observed that pandemic had an impact on these restrictions, especially as far as the screening mechanisms are concerned. Our session will count on colleagues from different parts of the globe to discuss the status quo of those restrictions.
